

CEO'S Statement Students Returning to Campus from 1 July 2020

Dear MCKL Students and Staff,

We are pleased to announce that in compliance with the Jabatan Pendidikan Tinggi (JPT) circular (Reference No.: JPT/GS 1000/519(9) dated Wednesday, 3 June 2020 and with the implementation of Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) period from Monday, 8 June 2020, MCKL will facilitate the return of students for selected teaching & learning activities as well as undertaking laboratory sessions from **Wednesday, 1 July 2020** for various programmes and cohorts of students.

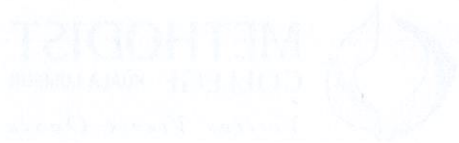
To facilitate this, students will return to the Campus in stages based on priorities, programme requirements and standard operating procedures issued by Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE), Ministry of Health (MOH) and National Security Council (MKN) respectively.

Students shall return to Campus from Wednesday, 1 July 2020 – Friday, 14 August 2020 for laboratory sessions first, and subsequently for selected teaching and learning activities until the end of the semester. This will involve specific cohorts only of the **American Degree Transfer Program, Australian Matriculation, Cambridge A-Level** and **Certified Accounting Technician (CAT)** programmes. Students enrolled in the Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Diploma in Social Work will continue their studies online.

A detailed timetable for the laboratory sessions and selected teaching and learning sessions will be released and shared with you by the respective Heads of Programme. Students are only required to be in Campus during the days and periods when your classes / labs are in session. Guidelines & procedures on attending laboratory sessions have also been prepared and shall also be shared with all students via a separate email.

Academic staff who are involved in conducting selected face-to-face teaching and learning activities and laboratory sessions will be required to return to Campus according to the revised class timetable from Wednesday, 1 July 2020. All administration staff are required to return to Campus and observe normal office working hours from Wednesday, 1 July 2020.

Throughout your presence in the Campus, all students are required to observe the standard operating procedures and guidelines issued by MCKL, MOHE, MOH and other government authorities for the conduct of academic and student activities under the new normal condition. Students must complete and submit the [Covid-19 Declaration Form](#) online before returning to Campus on 1 July 2020. Staff members who have not submitted the [Covid-19 Declaration Form](#) are reminded to do so before Wednesday, 1 July 2020.



We look forward to welcoming you back to College and the cooperation of everyone to maintain the Campus as a safe, healthy and conducive place for teaching and learning.
