Terms and Conditions for Merit Scholarship

- 1. The Merit Scholarship application is only open to all Malaysian, with blue identification card.
- 2. Applicants should be enrolled to a full-time programme and below the age at 25 before the date of application.
- 3. Only SPM/ IGCSE/ UEC/ A Level/ AUSMAT results received within 2 years from commencement date are accepted. Following is the equivalency of grades across SPM and IGCSE exams:

SPM	= Cambridge IGCSE Grade A*	
Grade A+	= Edexcel IGCSE Grade 9	

SPM	= Cambridge IGCSE Grade A
Grade A	= Edexcel IGCSE Grade 7 & 8

- 4. Applicants may combine results from different examination boards and multiple examination sittings, as long as there are no overlapping subjects and within a 12-month period.
- 5. This scholarship offer is considered null and void if the student fails to meet the minimum entry requirement as set by the MOE in their actual SPM results.
- 6. The scholarship reimbursement will commence from the second semester onwards. The tuition fees coverage for this scholarship are as follows:

Cambridge A Level	Maximum of 4 subjects (not including German Language subject)
American Degree Transfer Program	Maximum of 2 years or 65 cumulative credit hours, whichever comes first*
Diploma in Early Childhood Education	Maximum of 2.5 years or 90 cumulative credit hours, whichever comes first*
ACCA (Papers F1 to F3)	Maximum 6 months or 3 papers, whichever comes first*

^{*} Not inclusive of MPU subjects

- 7. This scholarship strictly does not cover any repeat paper or subject.
- 8. The scholarship application needs to be submitted to the Office of the Registrar before the end of the 6th week of the first semester. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 9. Applicants may apply for more than one MCKL scholarships/ financial aid at any one time but will have to choose only one if more than one award is offered.
- 10. Successful applicants are required to pay the first semester fees in full upon acceptance of the award before the commencement of the semester.
- 11. Students who have not fully settled their semester fees are not entitled to any scholarship reimbursement in the subsequent semester.
- 12. The award will be disbursed on a semester by semester basis. The final disbursement will be distributed upon the successful completion of the programme.
- 13. Recipients must not be on any scholarship, financial aid or sponsorship from any other entity at the time of application. Should they accept any scholarship, financial aid or sponsorship for their studies in MCKL from any other entity, they are obligated to inform the Registrar in writing of the source and amount of the award within two (2) weeks of the award date. The Institution reserves the right to withdraw or adjust the quantum of the MCKL scholarship received.
- 14. The scholarship waiver is based on the number of subjects (credit hour) attempted in the semester exams, not the number of subjects (credit hour) signed up. Withdrawn / Discontinued subjects are not entitled for scholarship waiver.
- 15. All scholarship recipients are expected to achieve at least 80% attendance at the Student General Meetings and participate actively in the activities organised by the Institution.
- 16. All scholarship recipients are required to pass Service Learning and Character Formation subjects in order to maintain the scholarship.
- 17. In the event that the recipient withdraws from the programme, defers to another intake, transfers to another program, is suspended or expelled by the Institution, at any point of time before the completion of the programme, this award shall automatically be revoked.
- 18. Any refund of fees is subject to the Terms and Conditions as stated in the Student Handbook.
- 19. Scholarship recipients may be required to participate in interviews, advertisements, photography or publicity-related activities for the purpose of promoting MCKL.
- 20. This award is given at the sole discretion of the Institution. Applicants are not guaranteed approval of the scholarships upon fulfilling the conditions set.
- 21. This award is only valid for the duration of the cohort of the programme enrolled and does not cover the extension of the programme beyond its minimum duration.
- 22. This award is not transferable or redeemable for cash and does not include external examination fees (if applicable) or textbooks.
- 23. MCKL reserves the right to amend any criteria and/or terms and conditions for scholarship as and when it deems necessary.

Additional Terms for 100% Merit Scholarship

- 1. Application for 100% Merit Scholarship are subject to approval of the Scholarship Board. Applicants are required to submit proof of household income (Tax Return form / Salary slips) to facilitate the application process.
- Students who are awarded 100% Merit Scholarship will not be entitled for any refund if they withdraw from the programme of study either before commencement or before completion of the programme.
- 3. 100% Merit Scholarship recipients are required to achieve a minimum GPA of 3.20 (ADTP, A Level, AUSMAT, DECE) or an average of 70% (CAT internal, ACCA external). In the computation of GPA, the internal exam marks for the A Level German Language subject will be included.
- 4. 100% Merit Scholarship recipients may be required to assist/participate in various activities organised by the Institution, up to a maximum of 20 hours per programme.

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
