

Pre-U Bridging Course Outline 2019

- According to a directive from the Ministry of Education, students can enrol into a pre-university programme that requires SPM results as an entry requirement with a conditional offer using their forecast results upon the completion of the SPM examinations, and only formally register in the pre-university programme after the actual SPM results are released and the entry requirements are met.

In line with this directive, MCKL is running a **Pre-U Bridging Course** beginning in January 2019 for two (2) months where students who have completed their SPM examinations can enrol based on their forecast / trial SPM results.

- Students who **successfully complete the Pre-U Bridging Course** will have the following benefits:
 - Eligibility to apply for Merit Scholarships using their forecast / trial results, and have the option of upgrading their scholarship if they achieve better grades in their official SPM results in March 2019.
 - Application Fee, Student Activities Fee, Academic Resource Fee and Development Fee** to be carried forward into the 1st semester of the A Level/AUSMAT programme if the student formally registers in the A Level/AUSMAT programme commencing in March 2019.
 - Booking Fee** to be carried forward as **Admission Deposit**. The Admission Deposit is refundable only after the student completes his/her A Level/AUSMAT programme.
 - Students need to pay Tuition Fee of RM3,000 only if he/she formally registers in the 1st semester of the A Level/AUSMAT programme after actual SPM results are released and the entry requirements are met.

FAQs

Q: What happens if I do not want to enrol for the A Level/AUSMAT course in March after completing the bridging course?

A: There is no obligation to continue. However, please note that students who wish to carry on will enjoy several benefits, as listed in section 4.

Q: Is the Pre-U Bridging Course covered by any scholarship?

A: Yes, with the condition that the student proceeds to formally register in the first semester of the A Level/AUSMAT programme and continue his/her studies in MCKL.

Q: Can I still change my subject combination upon completion of Pre-U Bridging Course?

A: No. Students are only allowed to change their subject combination within 2 weeks from commencement of Pre-U Bridging Course.

Q: Can I still change my Pre-U programme upon completion of Pre-U Bridging Course?

A: Yes, but students are deemed to have transferred to another programme 2 weeks after commencement of the Pre-U Bridging Course and the terms and conditions of the Student Handbook apply.

MCKL PRE-U BRIDGING COURSE DECLARATION FORM

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PRE-U BRIDGING COURSE 2019

1. Commencement date of the programme at Methodist College Kuala Lumpur (*hereinafter referred to as 'the College'*) is the first day of Orientation.
2. All students are automatically members of the student society of their respective programmes and will need to meet the attendance requirements.
3. All students are required to attend the compulsory Character Formation and Service Learning modules as part of the College's aim to provide a holistic education.
4. All applications for the MCKL Pre-U Bridging Course have to be submitted with the appropriate Application Fee and Booking Fee. At the same time, the Application Form for admission to the A Level / AUSMAT programme has to be submitted.
5. Applicants who have paid the Application Fee and Booking Fee will not be guaranteed a place in the programme unless full payment is made at least 7 calendar days before the commencement of the MCKL Pre-U Bridging Course.
6. Students must **successfully complete** the MCKL Pre-U Bridging Course in order to enjoy any of the benefits as listed in Section 4 of the Pre-U Bridging Course outline on the previous page.
7. Refund policy:
 - a) The **Application Fee** is not refundable under any circumstance.
 - b) Applicants who withdraw before the commencement date are required to submit the **Application for Refund before Programme Commencement** form to the Registrar's Office (via e-mail / hardcopy) in order to receive the refund.
 - c) Applicants who are awarded **100% Merit Scholarship** will not be entitled for any refund if they withdraw from the Pre-U Bridging Course or the A Level / AUSMAT programme either before commencement or before completion of the programme of study.
 - d) Applicants who withdraw within 14 calendar days from commencement date will only be refunded **50% of the fees paid (minus Application Fee, Laboratory Fee and Booking Fee)**.
 - e) Applicants who withdraw after 14 calendar days from commencement date will not be entitled to any refund.
 - f) All fees carried forward from the MCKL Pre-U Bridging Course into the first semester are not refundable under any circumstances.
 - g) Applicants who have completed the MCKL Pre-U Bridging Course and paid the balance tuition fee for their programme's first semester are not entitled to any refund should they decide to withdraw from the programme.
 - h) The refund policy for applicants under the MCKL Merit Scholarship, Special Scholarship and other awards is according to the Terms & Conditions of the respective MCKL Merit Scholarship, Special Scholarship and other awards.
 - i) All withdrawals after commencement of the programme of study are subject to the provisions of the Student Handbook.
 - j) If a student drops any A Level subject, the refund if any will be subject to the provisions of the Student Handbook.
8. Applicants who transfer from a programme of study or intake and then enrol into another programme or intake in the College before commencement of the original programme or intake, are eligible to have their fees transferred to the new programme of study or intake (*minus Application Fee*).
